2017-2018 SOAR! Income Guidelines	
Household Size	Household Income
2-3 persons	Up to \$44,700
4-6 persons	Up to \$60,750
7 or more persons	Up to \$72,000

Objective and Design:

- Provide tuition assistance to underserved students attending or who wish to attend Catholic elementary and high schools within the City of St. Louis and North St. Louis County.
- Enhance the sustainability of the designated schools and stimulate workforce and economic development for the greater St. Louis region.

Guidelines:

- Maximum award amount is \$4,000 per student per school year.
- Family is responsible for all fees.
- All applicants will be considered solely on the basis of financial need, regardless of their affiliation with any faith tradition.
- Awards will be granted to new and existing students, subject to funding availability.
- Awards renew through 8th grade graduation, upon annual income re-qualification.
- Awards transfer should the student transfer to another SOAR!-eligible elementary school.
- Families with multiple children can receive more than one SOAR! Scholarship.
- Scholarships may be awarded at the following schools, subject to funding availability:
